	Farms - Commodity/Wholesale	Farms that sell wholesale products to other businesses, such as milk from a dairy, grain or produce to a larger processor or meat to a wholesale processor or auction house.
	Farms - Direct Sales	Farms that sell retail products on-site or via farm stands directly to consumers (sweet corn, pumpkins, other produce, homemade foods, flour/whole grains, hops, Christmas trees); may also include meat sales in partnership with a butcher/processor.
	Farms & Agro-tourism	Any active farm of any type; This category may include agro-tourism such as hayrides, etc..
	Fitness	Physical Exercise & Recreation: Gyms, Exercise Facilities, Dance Schools, Active recreation (paddling, running, hiking etc) Clubs/Groups
	Food Processing & Wholesale Suppliers	Raw products & supplies for other businesses or the public: Packaging supplies; feed, grain & other ag-supplies, Mills, Butchers, Meat Processing, Cheese/Milk Plants, Hop processing, CBD processing
	Funeral & Memorial Services	Cemeteries, Funeral & Memorial venues, headstone & casket suppliers, officiants, etc..
	Garden Centers, Flower Shops, Plant Nurseries	Plants, Cut flowers, Bouquets/Balloons, tree nurseries
	Graphic Design & Printing Services	Generally not directly related to a single news or media resource; such as logo design, layout of a flyer or printing flyers, etc..
